'I would estimate that I place around 10 and 15 inserts each month as part of periodontal treatment programmes. My patients are well educated in their oral health status and are properly informed about which treatments I am able to offer. Initially, I carry out a full periodontal assessment, record probing and pocket depths and formulate a treatment plan.

'Appointments for root surface debridement are arranged and the patient is given comprehensive instructions and demonstrations in how to maintain optimum oral hygiene levels. I follow this with a review six weeks later to see if any healing has occurred and if pocket depths of at least 5mm are observed, active periodontal treatment using PerioChip® is implemented.

'For most patients I organise treatment with the placement of three PerioChip® inserts over three months for a total of nine months, in accordance with placement guidelines. Of course, I routinely review my periodontal patients to ensure treatment is progressing successfully but I find that this approach works very well to reduce periodontal pockets.

'Many of my patients have said that before treatment they know and feel that something is not right. However, when maintenance therapy using PerioChip® begins they can really feel the difference. The reduction in pocket depth after just one application is fantastic, which is difficult to achieve with root surface debridement alone. I usually see an improvement at each visit and with optimum conditions, I have seen a reduction of 2-4mm in pocket depths after just three months. It is reliable and effective and this is why PerioChip® is my choice for treating periodontal disease.

'PerioChip® allows my patients to brush their teeth and clean interdentally as normal. I only put forward patients with optimum oral health and good home regimes for treatment as it allows them to benefit from an effective treatment solution without reaching out for further procedures such as DNA testing and topical antimicrobials or antibiotics.
